**SUBJECT: HORIZON VIEW DRIVE – ESTABLISHMENT OF TIMED NO PARKING ZONE**

## **ISSUES:**

Establishment of Timed No Parking zone along a designated segment of both sides of Horizon View Drive south of Choi Drive.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Transportation Board recommend that the City Council approve:

1. Establishment of a “No Parking between the hours of 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Daily” zone on both sides of Horizon View Drive from Choi Drive to southerly the terminus.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The City works with residents and local businesses to establish various time restricted parking zones. Time restricted parking zones are utilized to control parking availability and may help to minimize safety, noise, or other concerns generated by parking during specific times of the day.

Establishment of time restricted parking zones requires submission of a petition from immediately impacted residents or businesses showing support from a minimum of 75% of tenants or owners for the proposed time restricted parking zone. Once petition criteria has been met, the proposal is scheduled for consideration by the Transportation Board who makes recommendation to the City Council regarding the matter.

## **DISCUSSION:**

The Public Works Department received a petition from eighty percent (80%) of impacted residents on Horizon View Drive and Choi Drive requesting establishment of a no parking between the hours of 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. daily” zone along both sides of Horizon View Drive, from Choi Drive to the southerly terminus. Residents indicate nighttime parking generates undesirable and illegal activity and littering.

Establishment of the proposed timed No Parking zone would restrict late night and early morning parking along both sides of Horizon View Drive, from Choi Drive to the southerly terminus.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The cost of signs is estimated to be \$108. Funding is available in the existing Public Works Department budget, Signing Supplies account number 4110100-424143, to cover this cost.
