

APPLICANT: City of Riverside

LOCATION: Generally bounded by Pellissier Ranch to the north, State Route 60 (SR-60) and portions of Main Street in Downtown Riverside to the south, Interstate 215 (I-215) and residences to the east, and the Santa Ana River to the west within the City of Riverside, the City of Colton, and the unincorporated County of Riverside.

PROPOSAL: Entitlements in conjunction with interiurisdictional proposed Northside Neighborhood and Pellisier Ranch Specific Plan (NSP) and Program Environmental Impact Report including (1) General Plan amendment to Table LU-2 - Adopted Specific Plans, Table 5 - Zoning/General Plan Consistency Matrix, Figure LU-9 - Neighborhoods, and Figure LU-10 - Land Use Policy Map of the Land Use and Urban Design Element of the General Plan to include the NSP, amend Objectives and Policies for consistency with the NSP, adjust neighborhood boundaries, and apply the NSP - Northside Specific Plan land use designation to the project area; (2) adoption of Specific Plan to create the NSP and amend the Downtown Specific Plan incorporating the North Main Street District into the NSP boundaries; (3) Zoning Code amendment to Title 19 (Zoning) of the Riverside Municipal Code to add Chapter 19.146 - Northside Specific Plan (NSP) and amend

relevant information in Chapter 19.220; and to rezone properties to the zones proposed in the Northside Specific Plan; and (4) Program Environmental Impact Report.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The Planning Commission recommends that the City Council: (1) adopt a resolution certifying that the Final Program Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the proposed project: (a) has been completed in compliance with the

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code 21000 et seq.); (b) will be presented to the City Council and the City Council will review and consider the information contained in the Final EIR prior to approving the project; and (c) reflects the City's independent judgment and analysis, and making certain findings of fact; (2) adopt the Findings of Fact; (3) adopt the Statement of Overriding Considerations; (4) adopt the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program; (5) concur with the findings contained in the Final Program EIR, the CEQA Resolution, the case file and the administrative record; and (6) find that no feasible alternatives to the project have been proposed that will avoid or substantially lessen the significant environmental effects as set forth in the Final Program EIR.
