ORDINANCE NO. 1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, 2 AMENDING CHAPTER 1.15, ELECTIONS, BY ADDING NEW SECTION 1.15.050 ESTABLISHING NO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS 3 FOR MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL CANDIDATES. 4 The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows: 5 Section 1.15.050 is hereby added to the Riverside Municipal Code as follows: Section 1: 6 "1.15.050 Campaign Contribution Limits. 7 8 On October 8, 2019, the Governor signed Assembly Bill 571, setting A. 9 campaign limits for elective city offices commensurate with State limits. 10 Assembly Bill 571 also authorized a city to set its own campaign contribution 11 limits different than the State limits. 12 B. The City Council hereby imposes no limit on the campaign contributions that 13 a Mayoral or City Council candidate can receive per election." 14 Section 2: The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and 15 information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony, 16 hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2), 17 15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title 18 14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change 19 in the environment nor have a significant impact on the environment. 20 Section 3: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause 21 publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter 22 of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its 23 adoption. 24 /// 25 /// 26 ///
