Homeless Mitigation Plans

Priority 1 – This is the old Boy Scout Camp area (Fairmount Park). The homeless count is approximately 75 people. This can be a continuation of a vegetation removal program that was started about three years ago.



Priority 2 – This includes Zone A and Zone C (Solar Farm). The homeless count is approximately 150 people. Zone A contains one of the largest and most sophisticated homeless encampments within the city. Zone C contains the large swath of vegetation immediately adjacent to the hillside.



Priority 3 – Shared area with Riverside County. The homeless count is approximately 200 people within this expanse. This area abuts the Wastewater Treatment facility.



Priority 4 – This is the riparian area adjacent to Doolittle. The homeless count is approximately 20 people. The city periodically cleans out this area, as it is a popular spot due to its location near retail (support) businesses.
