A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ALL NECESSARY APPLICATIONS, CONTRACTS, PAYMENT REQUESTS, AGREEMENTS AND AMENDMENTS IN THE PROCESS OF APPLYING FOR SECURING FUNDS UNDER THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY (CALRECYCLE) FOOD WASTE PREVENTION AND RESCUE GRANT PROGRAM

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WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code section 40000 et seq., the Department of Resource Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), is to administer various Grant Programs ("grants") in furtherance of the State of California's ("State") efforts to reduce overall greenhouse gas emissions by expanding existing or establish new food waste prevention and/or rescue projects in California to reduce the amount of food being disposed in landfills.

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority, CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Grant Program application procedures require an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2017, the City adopted Resolution number 23217 as required by CalRecycle's Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Grant Program; however, Resolution number 23217 expired on April 1, 2020, making a new resolution necessary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside ("City") desires to establish a Food Waste Reduction and Rescue Program in accordance with CalRecycle's Program and also desires to extend the City Manager or his designee authority to include the authority to apply for and secure the available funds on behalf of the City available under CalRecycle's Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Grant Program, and carryout all other purposes in the application process administered by CalRecycle, and such authority shall be valid from the date of adoption of this Resolution up to and including January 1, 2026.

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
2	California, as follows:
3	Section 1: The City Council of the City of Riverside does hereby authorize application to
4	CalRecycle for a Food Waste Prevention and Rescue Grant Program.
5	Section 2: The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute on
6	behalf of the City all necessary documents, including but not limited to applications, payment requests,
7	agreements and amendments thereto, necessary to secure grant funds and to implement the approved
8	grant project.
9	Section 3: The authority granted herein shall be valid until January 1, 2026.
