AHSC AWARD

On July 8, 2019 the State Department of Conservation alerted the City and Wakeland Housing of an AHSC award of \$16,826,931 that is broken down into a soft loan of \$7,030,231 for the Mission Heritage Housing Project (to be used exclusively by Wakeland) and an additional grant of \$9,796,700 for transportation projects that would be split between Wakeland and the City.
