Disability Rights California (DRC) is a protection and advocacy agency that works to improve the lives of people with disabilities by guarding against abuse, advocating for basic rights, and ensuring access and accountability in health care, education, employment, housing, transportation, voting, and within the juvenile and criminal justice systems. The mission of DRC is to advocate, educate, investigate, and litigate in order to advance the rights, dignity, equal opportunities, and choices for all people with disabilities.
