SUBJECT: MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL REGIONAL ORGANIZATION ASSIGNMENTS

ISSUE:

Recommend appointments for Mayor and City Council representatives to regional organizations.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee forward recommendations for Mayor and City Council appointments to regional organizations to the City Council.

BACKGROUND:

The City Council Rules of Procedure and Order of Business provide that following each election and/or appointment to fill a City Council vacancy, reorganization of City Council Standing Committee and regional organization assignments shall be considered by the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee for a recommendation to the City Council. The resolution further provides that to the greatest extent possible, preferences of senior Councilmembers shall be honored. Councilmembers shall forward preferences on assignments to the City Clerk to be shared at the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee meeting. City Council Standing Committee assignments were reorganized following renaming and repurposing of the Standing Committees on April 21, 2020.

On January 5, 2021, the City Council appointed Mayor Lock Dawson to represent the City on Riverside County Transportation Commission, Southern California Association of Governments Regional Council, and Western Riverside Council of Governments until preferences of the Mayor and City Council for all regional organizations were compiled for recommendation from the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee. The City Clerk compiled the preferences as attached to this report.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with assignments to regional organizations. Costs for participation of elected officials on regional organizations are included in the annual Budget.
