

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR UTILITY RELOCATION IMPROVEMENTS BETWEEN CITY OF CORONA AND CITY OF RIVERSIDE


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BACKGROUND

- 1. City of Corona to construct the McKinley Street Grade Separation Project (Project) over the existing BNSF railroad tracks in 2021.
- 2. The Project is located near the intersection of McKinley Street and Sampson Avenue, and extends from Magnolia Avenue north to State Route 91.
- 3. Project will relieve traffic congestion and improve safety for vehicles, pedestrians and bicyclists crossing over the railroad tracks.



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DISCUSSION

- 1. Approximately 1,300 LF of 12-inch pipeline in conflict with Grade Separation Project.
 - a. Approximately 600 LF of 12-inch main within McKinley Street to be relocated to a utility easement provided by Corona.
 - b. Approximately 400 LF of 12-inch main within Estelle Street to be abandoned and alternatively re-routed from Magnolia Avenue and Grant Street.

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DISCUSSION (CONT'D.)

- 2. City of Riverside has superior property rights that pre-date the establishment of existing City of Corona and County of Riverside right-of-way; consequently, water line relocations will be funded by City of Corona.
- 3. Cooperative Agreement between City of Corona and City of Riverside will reimburse RPU for design, construction and construction inspection costs related to water line relocation improvements, which is estimated at \$2,090,000.

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RECOMMENDATIONS

That the Board recommend that City Council:

- Approve the Cooperative Agreement for Utility Relocation Improvements between City of Corona and City of Riverside for reimbursement to City of Riverside in the amount of \$2,090,000 for McKinley Street Grade Separation Project Design, Construction, and Construction Inspection related to utility conflict mitigation within the project area of City of Corona's McKinley Street Grade Separation project;
- 2. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute the Cooperative Agreement and any amendments including those to increase the reimbursable amount of the agreement;



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RECOMMENDATIONS (CONT.)

- Authorize an increase in estimated revenue in the amount of \$2,020,000 to the Water Fund (520 Undesignated Reserve Fund) and appropriate expenditures in the same amount to a capital project account as established by the Finance Department to fund the project; and
- 4. Approve the capital expenditure of \$2,090,000 for Work Order No. 2026278 for the City of Riverside's design, construction and construction inspection costs for City of Corona's McKinley Street Grade Separation project.



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
