4	The City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain as follows:

6	Section 1: Section 9.04.400(D) of the Riverside Municipal Code is hereby amended as		
7	follows:		
8	"Section 9.04.400 Conduct on public property.		
9	D. Conduct on public property, monuments, decorative fountains and lawns. No		
10	person, after having been notified by a law enforcement officer that he or she is in		
11	violation of the prohibition in this section, shall:		
12	1. Walk, stand, sit or lie upon any monument, vase, decorative fountain, drinking fountain,		
13	bike rack, trash receptacle, median, fire hydrant, street tree planter berm, utility cabinet,		
14	railing, fence, planter, or upon any other public property not designed or customarily used		
15	for such purposes;		
16	2. Walk, stand, sit or lie upon any public lawn or planted area which is posted with signs that		
17	forbid such conduct; or		
18	3. Walk, stand or lie upon any public bench.		
19	4. Enter the water, swim, bathe, shave, wash clothes or otherwise pollute any decorative		
20	fountain, or allow any minor child or pet to do the same."		
21	Section 2: The City Council has reviewed the matter and, based upon the facts and		
22	information contained in the staff reports, administrative record, and written and oral testimony,		
23	hereby finds that this ordinance is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Sections 15060(c)(2),		
24	15060(c)(3) and/or 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, California Code of Regulations, Title		
25	14, Chapter 3, in that it will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change		
26	in the environment nor have a significant impact on the environment.		
27	Section 3: The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause		

28 publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter

1	1 of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective	e on the 30th day after the date of its	
2	2 adoption.
