

REFERRAL OF CITY OF RIVERSIDE SERVICES PROTECTION MEASURE TO THE CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE

BACKGROUND

- 1. City Charter (Charter) has called for transfers from its electric utility to the General Fund since voters adopted the first Charter in 1907.
- 2. In 1968, Riverside voters adopted a Charter amendment that specifically called for a general fund transfer (GFT) from utilities in "an amount equal to 11.5% of the [utilities'] gross operating revenues."
- 3. City Charter Section 1204, subdivision (f), currently allows a GFT in "an amount not to exceed 11.5%" of the utilities' gross operating revenues for the prior fiscal year.
 - a. This language was approved by 64.5% of Riverside voters in 1981.

GENERAL FUND TRANSFER (GFT)

- The GFT provides an unrestricted revenue source to the General Fund
 - a. Funds services that include, but are not limited to: 911 response, fire, paramedic, police, street repairs, parks, senior services, homelessness and other general services
- 2. The Electric Transfer currently provides approximately \$40 million annually, or about 14% of the total General Fund operating budget

BALLOT MEASURE

- To maintain this critical General Fund revenue source, staff is recommending that the voters consider a ballot measure at the June 8, 2021 election which would amend the Riverside City Charter to add a section confirming the Electric Transfer limited to 11.5% of gross revenue.
- 2. The Charter amendment requires a review by the Charter Review Committee prior to the City Council's consideration to place the measure on the ballot.
 - a. Charter Review Committee is tentatively scheduled to meet on February 17, 2021
 - b. March 12, 2021 is the last day to place a measure on the ballot.
