This project generally includes, but is not limited to, the resurface of asphalt pavement with conventional, rubberized, or fiber-reinforced and ARAM treatments; reconstructing damaged concrete sidewalks, driveways, pedestrian ramps, cross gutters, curbs, and gutters; adjustment of water meters boxes, water valve covers, and sewer, storm drain, and electric manholes; and replacement of traffic striping, signs, and loops.
