

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, RENEWING THE RATE FOR  
4 COUNTY SERVICE AREA (CSA) 152 TO FUND ACTIVITIES TO  
5 COMPLY WITH THE CITY'S NATIONAL POLLUTANT  
DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (NPDES) PERMIT FOR  
MUNICIPAL STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) DISCHARGES  
FOR FISCAL YEARS 2021-2022 THROUGH 2023-2024.

6 WHEREAS, the City of Riverside ("City") is a co-permittee under the National Pollution  
7 Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") Permit for Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System  
8 ("MS4") discharges; and

9 WHEREAS, under the NPDES Permit, the City is required to regulate discharges of urban  
10 runoff, prevent unauthorized and potentially hazardous discharges into Waters of the United States,  
11 and carry out programs and activities to maintain compliance with the NPDES Permit; and

12 WHEREAS, County Service Area ("CSA") 152 was formed and established pursuant to  
13 Riverside County Ordinance number 573 in November 1991 to establish a funding mechanism to  
14 meet the NPDES Permit requirements; and

15 WHEREAS, the funds collected assist in funding the City's responsibilities under the  
16 NPDES Permit, such as programs for storm drain maintenance, street sweeping, storm water  
17 monitoring, and compliance with Total Maximum Daily Load requirements for the Santa Ana River  
18 and Canyon Lake/Lake Elsinore; and

19 WHEREAS, on April 13, 2012, the City adopted Resolution No. 22369 authorizing the  
20 County to increase CSA 152 assessments to assist in funding the City's responsibilities under the  
21 NPDES Permit effective with the 2012-2013 property tax bills by an additional \$2.39 per Benefit  
22 Assessment Unit ("BAU") to \$5.22 per BAU; and

23 WHEREAS, on March 25, 2014, the City adopted Resolution No. 22665 authorizing the  
24 County to increase CSA 152 assessments from \$5.22 to \$10.00 per BAU over a three-year period;  
25 and

26 WHEREAS, on March 28, 2017, the City adopted Resolution No. 23163 authorizing the  
27 County to maintain CSA 152 assessments at \$10.00 per BAU; and  
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1 WHEREAS, on March 28, 2018, the City adopted Resolution No. 23289 authorizing the  
2 County to maintain CSA 152 assessments at \$10.00 per BAU for the 2018-2019 fiscal year; and

3 WHEREAS, on March 12, 2019, the City adopted Resolution No. 23427 authorizing the  
4 County to maintain CSA 152 assessments at \$10.00 per BAU for the 2019-2020 fiscal year; and

5 WHEREAS, on March 3, 2020, the City adopted Resolution No. 23551 authorizing the  
6 County to maintain CSA 152 assessments at \$10.00 per BAU for the 2020-2021 fiscal year; and

7 WHEREAS, the City and County desire to renew the CSA 152 assessments; and

8 WHEREAS, \$10.00 per BAU is the maximum assessment authorized by the County for CSA  
9 152 and the County does not plan to increase the assessment in the near future; and

10 WHEREAS, the Public Works Department is recommending that the assessment remain at  
11 \$10.00 per BAU for Fiscal Years 2021-2022 through 2023-2024, to enable the City to continue to  
12 carry out its responsibilities under the NPDES Permit; and

13 WHEREAS, the fiscal impact of the CSA 152 assessment will positively affect the General  
14 Fund and other funds which currently lend support to the storm water program; and

15 WHEREAS, failure to comply with the NPDES Permit can result in fines of \$10,000 per day,  
16 per violation or greater.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,  
18 California, as follows:

19 Section 1: The City Council hereby finds and determines that each and every recital set  
20 forth above is true and correct.

21 Section 2: The City Council requests that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors  
22 renew the CSA 152 assessments within the City of Riverside at an annual rate of \$10.00 per benefit  
23 assessment unit for Fiscal Years 2021-2022 through 2023-2024.
