## RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, OFFERING A REWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 FOR INFORMATION LEADING TO THE DETERMINATION OF THE IDENTITY OF, AND THE APPREHENSION OF, THE PERSON OR PERSONS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MURDER OF KEITH WHITNEY ALLEN.

WHEREAS, the City of Riverside may offer and pay rewards as authorized by Section 53069.5 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, Section 53069.5 specifically authorizes the City to offer and pay a reward, the amount thereof to be determined by the City for information leading to the determination of the identify of, and the apprehension of, any person whose willful misconduct results in injury or death to any person; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2001, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 19873, approving the Riverside Police Department's Reward Program and authorizing its implementation; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, August 21, 2020, at approximately 6:03 a.m., Riverside Police Department officers were dispatched to a call of a "subject down" at the intersection of 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Commerce Avenue, in the City of Riverside; and

WHEREAS, officers arrived and located the victim, later identified as Mr. Keith Whitney Allen, lying face down suffering from multiple gunshot wounds; and

WHEREAS, medical personnel attempted life saving measures, however Mr. Allen succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at 6:11 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, Riverside Police Department's Robbery – Homicide Unit responded and assumed the investigation with the assistance of the Gang Intelligence Unit and the Forensic Unit; and

WHEREAS, Riverside Police Department detectives and officers canvassed the neighborhood surrounding the incident for surveillance footage and witnesses, however no witnesses to the shooting were located; and

WHEREAS, surveillance footage was obtained which showed a possible suspect vehicle driving around the neighborhood before the shooting, however the footage was too dark to determine the make and/or model of the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, investigators learned Mr. Keith Whitney Allen was a resident of the City of Hemet and a native of the State of Texas, and was employed at 220 Laboratories in the City of Riverside and rode the RTA bus to work; and

WHEREAS, on the morning of August 21, 2020, Mr. Allen had finished his shift as a factory warehouse worker and had left around 4:15 a.m., and is believed that have proceeded towards a bus stop when he was gunned down; and

WHEREAS, a press release was distributed regarding the incident, but information has yet to be obtained; and

WHEREAS, Riverside Police Department investigators have worked tirelessly to solve this unsolved crime; and

WHEREAS, investigators believe that there may be witnesses with information to this crime who have not yet come forward; and

WHEREAS, the offer would be consistent with and is taken for the immediate protection of public peace, health, and safety; and

WHEREAS, the offense was of such a nature or committed under special circumstances that as a matter of public policy, the City of Riverside should provide a reward as an added inducement or incentive for persons to come forth with information leading to the arrest of the perpetrator(s); and

WHEREAS, the offense was especially heinous, atrocious, or cruel and manifested exceptional depravity; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that a reward in the amount of \$30,000 is hereby approved and authorized for information leading to the determination of the identity of, and the apprehension of, any person responsible for the acts stated above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the offer of reward by the City shall be effective for a period of sixty (60) days or for the term of any extension thereof which may be approved by the City
