- SUBJECT: COMMISSIONER DON COON'S ABSENCE FROM THE COMMISSION ON DISABILITIES MEETING ON JANUARY 21, 2021

ISSUE:

Determine whether Commissioner Don Coon's absence on January 21, 2021, should be recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Commission on Disabilities determine if Commissioner Don Coon's absence from their meeting on January 21, 2021 should be excused or unexcused.

BACKGROUND:

On July 26, 2016, City Council approved the recommendation from the Governmental Affairs Committee to amend the Board/Commission Attendance Policy. The policy states, "Board/Commission members shall make every effort to notify the Chairperson or his/her designee no later than 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. A member's inability to provide 24 hours advance notice shall not preclude the board/commission from exercising its discretion to excuse said absence as outlined in Section 805 of the City Charter."

DISCUSSION:

Commissioner Coon was not present at the meeting on January 21, 2021. Staff received advance notice from Commissioner Coon that he wouldn't be able to virtually attend the meeting.
