- 3. Update operations for the 21st century

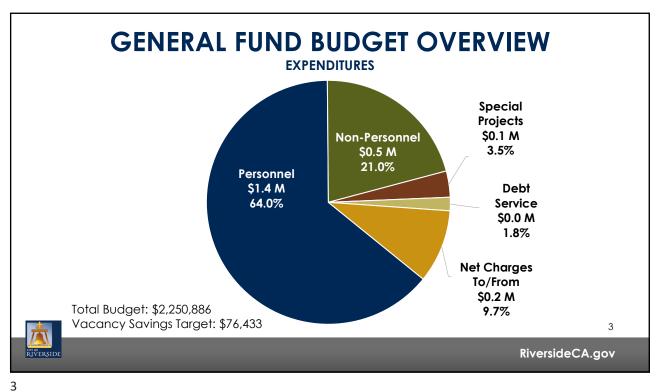
