SUBJECT: BOARD OF PUBLIC UTILITIES INTERVIEWS FOR CITYWIDE SEAT

ISSUE:

Interview applicants for the Board of Public Utilities Citywide seat.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Mayor and City Council interview applicants for the Citywide seat on the Board of Public Utilities for a term ending March 1, 2025.

BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

Section XIV(A) of the City Council Rules of Procedure and Order of Business (Resolution No. 23618) provides that for vacancies on the Community Police Review Commission, Board of Ethics, Planning Commission, and Board of Public Utilities, the Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee review applications submitted and identify applicants for interview with the Mayor and City Council. The City Clerk notifies the Mayor and City Council of those selected for interview. The Mayor and each member of the City Council may add additional applicants for interview, if desired. The Mayor and City Council immediately vote on the appointments following the interviews. With a full quorum, five affirmative votes are required.

The Mayor's Nominating and Screening Committee met on February 9, 2021, with Chair Lock-Dawson and Members Melendrez and Conder present, and unanimously recommended that the City Council (1) interview John F. Gurrola, Beth M. Hill-Skinner, Melinda A. Weinrich, Pasquale (Patrick) V. Gabriele, Wayne G. McNamee, Sergio Robles, Brian D. Siana, Marc Troast, Michael R. Allison, Duffy Atkinson, Amanda J. Duran, Malissa H. McKeith, Thomas H. Safford, Jennifer L. Shepardson, Ronald T. Brees, David W. Eich, Sean Mill, and Richard T. Rogers for the Board of Public Utilities Citywide seat for a term through March 1, 2025.

Interviews will continue on Wednesday, March 30, 2021, before the City Council makes an appointment recommendation.
