I grew up in the Eastside, studied here thru college, and worked at some of our most culturally significant places such as the Fox Theater, Municipal Auditorium, and the Citrus Park, in addition to local businesses and Riverside Public Utilities. My life's ambition is to be the Mayor of Riverside, and I am looking to not just prove my skills and dedication by joining on a board or commission, but to make actual, positive impact for all my people that call this place home.

EXPERIENCE OR SPECIAL KNOWLEDGE PERTAINING TO AREA(S) OF INTEREST:

For all three of these boards I have had some relevant experience through my various roles over the years. My work at Riverside Public Utilities as in intern while in college and my current role at the Center for Sustainable Energy has granted me insight to the challenges utilities will increasingly face in the future as residents begin to rely less on the grid and more on distributed energy resource technology. My work as a community advocate in the Eastside and an organizer during my time at UCR gave me the opportunity to witness first-hand the needs and challenges our community faces in terms of crime but as well as their perception and needs regarding public law enforcement our need for better collaboration between all groups in this sector. Lastly, my work on promoting fiscally prudent projects in this city, particularly my previous work in advocating for the preservation of the Downtown library at its historic site, kicked off my understanding of the need to plan responsibly so as to not decimate what should be a balanced budget for our city. 2. Describe your experience with or knowledge of local government finance:

My experience with governmental finance in our city has not been with numbers or behind spreadsheets. Rather, my experience with finance has been first-hand advocacy and representation for working-class Riversiders in regards to the impact that large projects and construction has on the city. In 2015 and 2016 while the city was considering the development of a new library in Downtown, my brother and I believed that the construction of such a building at that time was not prudent in terms of the city's finances. The city was still coming out of a difficult time due to the great recession and we had a general understanding that if a tighter leash was not kept on municipal expenditures, our city would eventually go the way of San Bernardino. We worked tirelessly to speak with the community and urge them to help us and promote that we keep the library at its old Downtown location, not simply as a matter of historic reusability of such a great building, but as a matter of fiscal prudence; it became evident that a new building, with an appropriate budget to match, would further add to city expenditures. I believe that my experience here, and the rest I have gained since then, has cemented my judgement in analyzing what a fiscally prudent decision is for the city. There are many problems our budget currently faces, and I aim to ensure my city plans for the future.
