BACKGROUND:

The Airport Manager's Operation and Activity Report is provided to inform the Airport Commission (Commission) about operations, City Council actions, events, meetings and other issues concerning the Riverside Municipal Airport (Airport).

Recent City Council and Committee Actions:

On March 23, 2021, City Council approved the Airport's Fiscal Year 2020/21 Federal Aviation Administration Grant application for \$133,458. This Grant provides for an emergency generator for airfield lighting, new airfield signage and windsock relocation.

On March 23, 2021, City Council approved the Airport's request for an allocation from the Airport Fund of \$160,000 for emergency facility maintenance and repairs. The following is a breakdown of those funds:

\$20,000 – emergency plumbing, door and window repairs

\$40,000 - for the acquisition and installation of a new HVAC system for the Airport Café

\$100,000 – for roof repairs caused by recent windstorms.

Upcoming City Council and Committee Actions:

At the time of this report, Request for Proposals No. 2088 for an Aircraft Hangar Development located along Gemende Drive has been issued, with responses due on April 16, 2021. Staff will review and evaluate the submitted proposals and make a recommendation to the City Council. The successful proposer is anticipated to enter into a long-term lease to construct, manage and maintain several new hangars

Other activities and events

No activities or events took place during March of April.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact associated with receiving this monthly activity report.
