### SUBJECT: CONSIDER WHETHER COMMISSIONER ABSENCE FOR THE MARCH 18, 2021 REGULAR MEETING SHOULD BE RECORDED AS AN EXCUSED OR UNEXCUSED ABSENCE - COON

### ISSUE:

Determine whether the absence of Commissioner Don Coon on March 18, 2021, should be recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Commission on Disabilities determine if the absence of Commissioner Don Coon on March 18, 2021, should recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

### BACKGROUND:

On July 26, 2016, City Council approved the recommendation from the Governmental Affairs Committee to amend the Board/Commission Attendance Policy. The policy states, "Board/Commission members shall make every effort to notify the Chairperson or his/her designee no later than 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. A member's inability to provide 24 hours advance notice shall not preclude the board/commission from exercising its discretion to excuse said absence as outlined in Section 805 of the City Charter."

#### DISCUSSION:

Staff received notice prior to the March 18, 2021 meeting that Commissioner Coon would not be in attendance at the virtual meeting.
