# **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Cultural Heritage Board receive, and, if applicable, provide input to the City Clerk, during the annual review of the Code of Ethics and Conduct.

# BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Chapter 2.78 of the Riverside Municipal Code (Exhibit 1) established a Code of Ethics and Conduct for elected officials and members of appointed boards, commissions, and committees. The Code requires that prior to the end of July of each year, the boards, and commissions place this on an agenda and discuss at a regular meeting the Code of Ethics and Conduct.

Comments from the Cultural Heritage Board may be submitted to the Board of Ethics in writing or in person at their meeting on Thursday, August 5, 2021. The City Council Inclusiveness, Community Engagement, and Governmental Processes Committee will consider the Board of Ethics recommendations on September 1, 2021. The City Council will conduct a public hearing prior to the end of the year to consider all recommendations.
