LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

- 1. AB 1668 and SB 606 (2018) establish a long-term water conservation and drought planning framework for California water providers.
- 2. Urban retail water suppliers required to set and meet a "water use objective" (WUO) for their service areas using a water budget-based approach by November 2023.
- 3. WUO will combine indoor and outdoor residential water use, commercial, industrial, and institutional (CII) outdoor irrigation, and efficient water loss.

BACKGROUND

- Santa Ana Watershed Project Authority (SAWPA) is implementing a
 project to assist a few agencies in the Santa Ana watershed
 to calculate the landscaped areas of CII customers with
 dedicated irrigation meters.
- 2. This information will help calculate the CII outdoor water use component of the retailers' water use objective.
- 3. Using Prop 84 grant funding no cost to participating agencies.

DISCUSSION

- 1. CII classification is complex
 - DWR relying on agencies to calculate landscaped areas of these customers (i.e. business parks and recreational parks)
- 2. CII landscaped area will be added to residential indoor and outdoor water use and efficient water loss to create City's WUO.
- 3. Participation requires MOU between SAWPA and City.

DISCUSSION

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

- 1. Requires participating agency commit some of their staffing resources to work with SAWPA and its consultant over span of 1-1.5 years.
- 2. If City does not participate in this project, work will be done inhouse or consultant may need to be hired, requiring additional resources and expenses otherwise covered by SAWPA's assistance program.
