SUBJECT: RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULTS OF JUNE 8, 2021, GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR WARDS 2, 4, AND 6

ISSUE:

Adopt a resolution declaring the results of the June 8, 2021, General Municipal Election to elect Members of the City Council from Wards 2, 4, and 6 for five-year terms.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt the attached resolution reciting the fact of the General Municipal Election held on June 8, 2021, to elect Members of the City Council for Wards 2, 4, and 6 for five-year terms and declaring the results.

BACKGROUND:

Per Elections Code Section 15372, on June 24, 2021, the Registrar of Voters completed the canvass of returns for the General Municipal Election conducted on June 8, 2021, and prepared the attached Statement of Vote. The City Attorney prepared the attached draft resolution to declare the results of the election. The candidates for Wards 2, 4, and 6 are shown below:
