

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE
4 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN SAID CITY ON
5 THE 8TH DAY OF JUNE, 2021 DECLARING THE RESULTS
6 THEREOF AND SETTING FORTH SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS
7 ARE PROVIDED BY LAW.

8 WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of
9 Riverside on the 8th day of June, 2021, as required by law for the purpose of electing members
10 of the City Council for Wards 2, 4, and 6; and

11 WHEREAS, notice of said election was duly and regularly given in the time, form and
12 manner as provided by law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were
13 appointed and in all respects said election was held and the returns made and declared in the
14 time, form, and manner as required by the provisions of the Charter of the City of Riverside and
15 the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in the City of Riverside;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 23670 adopted on the 19th day of January, 2021,
18 for the purpose of electing a member of the City Council from the Second, Fourth, and Sixth
19 Wards of said City of Riverside for five-year terms the appropriate County official canvassed the
20 returns of said election and has certified the results to this City Council and said results are
21 received, attached, and made a part hereof as Exhibit "A".

22 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, as
23 follows:

24 Section 1: That there were 9 voting precincts in the Second Ward; 9 voting precincts in
25 the Fourth Ward; 8 voting precincts in the Sixth Ward; and 26 voting precincts citywide.

26 Section 2: That said General Municipal Election was held for the purpose of electing
27 three (3) members of the City Council of the City of Riverside from Wards 2, 4, and 6 of the City
28 of Riverside as established by the City Council for five-year terms.

Section 3: That the whole number of votes cast in the Second Ward in the City of

1 Riverside was 5046; that the whole number of votes cast in the Fourth Ward in the City of
2 Riverside was 6426; that the whole number of votes cast in the Sixth Ward in the City of
3 Riverside was 1932.

4 Section 4: That the names of the persons voted for at said election and the office which
5 each person was voted for are as follows:

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18 That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City
19 to each of said persons above named for the respective offices for which said persons were
20 candidates are listed on the attached Exhibit "A".
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22 Section 5: That the City Council does declare and determine that Clarissa Cervantes was
23 elected as a member of the City Council from the Second Ward of said City to serve for the full
24 term of five years.

25 Section 6: That the City Council does declare and determine that Chuck Conder was
26 elected as a member of the City Council from the Fourth Ward of said City to serve for the full
27 term of five years.

28 Section 7: That the City Council does declare and determine that Jim Perry was elected

1 as a member of the City Council from the Sixth Ward of said City to serve for the full term of
2 five years.

3 Section 8: That the City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of said City
4 a statement of the results of the General Municipal Election held on June 8, 2021, showing:

- 5 (1) The whole number of votes cast in the City;
6 (2) The names of the persons voted for;
7 (3) The office each person was voted for;
8 (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each of said persons; and
9 (5) The number of votes given in the City to each of said persons;

10 Section 9: That pursuant to Section 400 of the Riverside City Charter and Election Code
11 §10265, the City Clerk shall deliver to the person so elected, a Certificate of Election signed by
12 her and duly authenticated; that she shall also administer to each person elected, the Oath of
13 Office prescribed in the State Constitution of the State of California and shall have them
14 subscribe thereto and file the same in her office; whereupon, said persons so elected shall be
15 inducted in to the office to which they have been elected.
