2.62 - DISCUSSION OF BOARD INITIATIVES

ISSUES:

Review of a Transportation Board adopted Bylaws and Riverside Municipal Code (RMC) Chapter 2.62. and discussion of Board initiatives.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Transportation Board:

- 1. Review and discuss the adopted Board Bylaws;
- 2. Review and discuss the Transportation Board duties under RMC Chapter 2.62; and
- 3. Discuss Transportation Board initiatives.

BACKGROUND:

The Transportation Board serves the City of Riverside by acting in an advisory capacity to the Mayor and City Council regarding issues related to public parking and the operation and management of City streets as well as reviewing and providing recommendations pertaining to specific traffic projects, regulations, and City Plans as outlined in the attached Bylaws and RMC Chapter 2.62.

DISCUSSION:

To continually meet the goals and objectives of the Transportation Board periodic review of the Board Bylaws, powers, duties, and functions, as well as regulations is recommended. This review will serve as a reminder of established rules and purview and facilitate discussion of potential Board initiatives. Re-examination of the Board's defined scope will aid Board members in identifying and presenting key issues which are appropriate for Board consideration and discussion.
