My experience with governmental finance in our city has not been with numbers or behind spreadsheets. Rather, my experience with finance has been first-hand advocacy and representation for working-class Riversiders in regards to the impact that large projects and construction has on the city. In 2015 and 2016 while the city was considering the development of a new libray in Downtown, my brother and I believed that the construction of such a building at that time was not prudent in terms of the city's finances. Completion of a Background Personal Information form; live scan fingerprint process through the FBI and Department of Justice, a local police records check, a records check of the National Crime Information Center (NCIC), and a DMV records check that includes vehicles registered to the applicant. The purpose of the DMV records check is due to liability issues since Commissioners occasionally drive their personal vehicles to public outreach events. The background check takes approximately two weeks to complete.
