It is time to re-imagine public safety. A citizen oversight entity can be critical in balancing the competing demands of public safety, and ensure that both law enforcement and the public's point of view and perspectives can be heard, understood, and that they are an essential part of delivering public safety. In my work at Advancement Project California (see below), I have been honored to work with Constance L. Rice, one of the architects of community-based policing in this country. Ms. Rice also helped to pioneer the Community Safety Partnership between the LAPD and multiple public housing projects across LA, as well as the Summer Night Lights program. The examples of this work have shown me that it is possible for peace officers to work with community in a mutually-satisfactory manner that builds trust AND reduces crime, and the hopelessness that it creates in neighborhoods.


