1. Why is the acquisition restricted to this good/service/supplier? (Explain why the acquisition cannot be competitively bid, and Include consequences that would occur from not contracting with this supplier.)

Underground Service Alert of Southern California aka DigAlert is a one call notification center for anyone planning to dig 9 Southern California counties; including Riverside County. Membership with Underground Service Alert of Southern Cal is for all persons, firms, corporations, and governmental or public entities or agencies who own or maintain underground facilities. California State Law, Code 4216, states you must contact DigAlert before you dig.

Dig Safe Board is a regulator and investigatory Board responsible for coordinating the state's education, developing safe standards, investigating dig-in accidents, enforcing violations of the Dig Safe Law, and making enforcement recommendate to the Contractors State License Board, the Public Utilities Commission, and the Office of the State Fire Marshal.

2. How was the price offered determined to be fair and reasonable? Explain what the basis was for comparison and include cost analyses as applicable. The Dig Safe Board fee is determined by dividing the number of tickets submitted (previous year) by the statewide numbitickets submitted (previous year), then multiplying that by the Board operations expenses (current year).

California State Law, Code 4216.1, states "Every operator of a subsurface installation, except the Department of Transposhall become a member of, participate in, and share the cost of, a regional notification center."

The amount of the Purchase Order is not to exceed \$100K.
