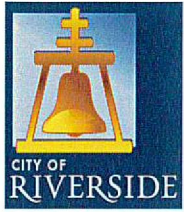
ESTABLISHMENT OF 5-TON WEIGHT LIMIT & AXLE RESTRICTIONS – COYOTE BUSH ROAD & SEGMENT IF WESTBOUND VAN BUREN BOULEVARD

Following discussion, it was moved member Hemenway and seconded by Vice-Chair Perry to 1) Establish a 5 ton weight limit restriction on Coyote Bush Road from Van Buren to Aptos Lane; and 2) Establish an axle restriction prohibiting use by commercial vehicles exceeding three (3) axles on westbound Van Buren Boulevard from Coyote Bush Road to Dauchy Avenue. The motion carried unanimously.
