  information guide.

#### **BALLOT ARGUMENTS**

- 3. If more than one argument for or against any measure is submitted, one will be selected based on the following preference and priority:
  - a) The City Council, or one or more Councilmember authorized by the City Council
  - b) An individual voter, or bona fide association of citizens, or combination or voters and associations who are the sponsors or proponents of the measure
  - c) Bona fide association of citizens
  - d) Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

That the City Council:

- Adopt Resolution Ordering, Calling, Providing for, and Giving Notice of a Special Municipal Election to be held in Said City on November 2, 2021 for the purpose of submitting a ballot measure amending the City Charter, repealing Resolution No. 23740;
- 2. Consider whether to defer submitting a ballot argument in favor of the proposed ballot measure if ballot arguments are submitted by other individual voters, or a bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, or individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure.
