ISSUE:

Determine whether the absence of Commissioner Megan G. Demshki on August 12, 2021, should be recorded as an excused or unexcused absence.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the Budget Engagement Commission determine the absence of Commissioner Megan G. Demshki from the Budget Engagement Commission meeting on August 12, 2021, be excused.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to the Board/Commission Attendance Policy Resolution No. 23437, Board Members shall make every effort to notify the administrative staff 24 hours prior to any regular meeting of his/her intent not to attend said meeting. The Board is required to express in its official minutes if the absence of the Board Member is excused or unexcused.

Pursuant to City Charter Section 805, if a member of a board or commission is absent from three consecutive regular meetings, unless by permission of the board or commission expressed in its official minutes, the City Council can declare the office vacant.

DISCUSSION:

Commissioner Demshki was not present at the Commission meeting on August 12, 2021. Staff received advance notification from Commissioner Demshki reporting her absence as an illness.
