



Bid 7852 – La Sierra Neighborhood Sidewalk Improvements

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BACKGROUND

- On September 26, 2013, Governor Brown signed legislation creating the Active Transportation Program (ATP) to encourage the use of active modes of transportation—biking and walking.
- The ATP Cycle III call for Projects was issued in April 2016.
- On June 15, 2016, the Public Works Department submitted for \$999,000 of the ATP III grant funds and committed a local match of \$216,000.



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CURRENT PROJECT

1. Remove conflicting existing trees, landscaping, irrigation, and relocate existing gates, fences, mailboxes, and water meters.
2. Construct curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveway approaches, and curb ramps to conform to the American with Disabilities Act requirements.
3. Resolve drainage issues within the project limits.



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CURRENT PROJECT (CONT.)

4. Replace and install new traffic street signs and striping, as necessary.
5. Install new electrical conduits, pullboxes, and streetlights.

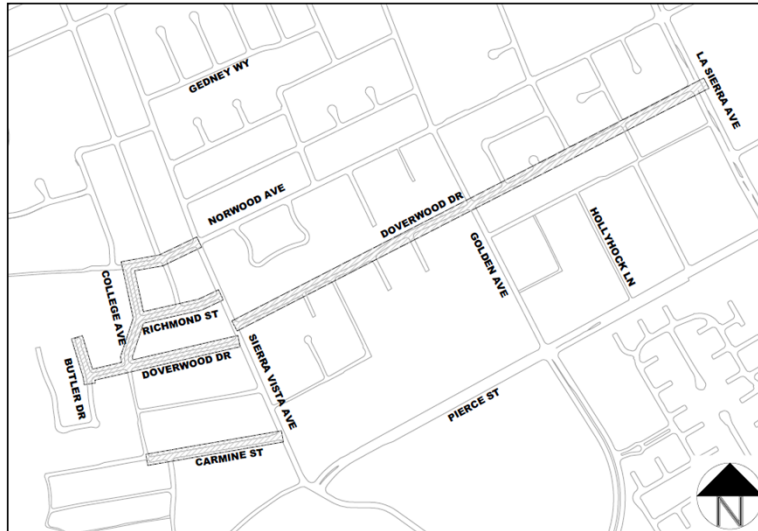


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LOCATION MAP

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COMPETITIVE BIDS

- On June 24, 2021, seven responsive bids were received.
- Lowest responsive bid is from LC Paving & Sealing, Inc. of Escondido, California.
- Bid Amount is \$1,977,212.83 (16.19% under engineer's estimate).
