BACKGROUND

- A City-wide action plan is needed:
 - Eligibility requirement for HHAP 3 (\$8.4M)
 - July 2021 California Comeback Plan
 - Reduce homelessness
 - Reduce first-time homelessness
 - Increase permanent housing placements
 - Reduce duration of homelessness
 - Reduce returns to homelessness
 - Increase successful placements from street outreach

- Increase availability and effectiveness of shelter beds;
- 4. Build a coordinated regional infrastructure;
- Increase availability of services, with a focus on physical & mental health and substance abuse treatment;
- 6. Expand **public awareness & education** about homelessness & housing.
