

The city was still coming out of a difficult time due to the great recession and we had a general understanding that if a tighter leash was not kept on municipal expenditures, our city would eventually go the way of San Bernardino. We worked tirelessly to speak with the community and urge them to help us and promote that we keep the library at its old Downtown location, not simply as a matter of historic reusability of such a great building, but as a matter of fiscal prudence; it became evident that a new building, with an appropriate budget to match, would further add to city expenditures.
