

1 RESOLUTION NO.

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA,
3 AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A STANDARD AGREEMENT TO
4 APPLY FOR, AND RECEIPT OF, HOMELESS HOUSING, ASSISTANCE
5 AND PREVENTION PROGRAM ROUND 3.

6 WHEREAS, the State of California's ("State") Homeless Coordinating and Financing Council
7 ("HCFC") in the Business, Consumer Services and Housing Agency ("Agency") is authorized to
8 provide up to \$1 billion to the 13 largest cities, counties, and continuum of cares for assistance under
9 pursuant to Chapter 6 (commencing with Section 50216) of Part 1 of Division 31 of the Health and
10 Safety Code (Amended by Stats. 2021, Ch. 111, Sec. 4. (AB 140) Effective July 19, 2021); and

11 WHEREAS, HCFC announced the HHAP 3 funding allocations for the City of Riverside
12 ("Applicant"), which is \$8,433,288.22; and

13 WHEREAS, on September 15, 2021, HCFC released a Standard Agreement to Apply for
14 HHAP 3 program funding. The submission deadline is October 15, 2021; and

15 WHEREAS, the Applicant is one of the 13 largest cities to receive a direct allocation of HHAP
16 3 funding. To receive these funds, the Applicant must submit a Standard Agreement to Apply for
17 HHAP 3 funding by the submission deadline of October 15, 2021; and

18 WHEREAS, HHAP 3 funding will have at minimum two funding disbursements – an initial
19 disbursement after submitting the Standard Agreement to Apply and a remainder disbursement after
20 submitting the HHAP-3 Application – as well as a potential third bonus disbursement if HHAP-3
21 performance goals are met. The Standard Agreement to Apply affects the initial disbursement of
22 HHAP-3 funding. Grantees that choose to apply individually will receive 20 percent of their total
23 allocation as the initial disbursement prior to submitting a HHAP-3 application; and

24 WHEREAS, the Applicant will receive the remaining 80% of the HHAP 3 funding after the
25 Applicant has submitted the required local homelessness action plan to HCFC and HCFC has approved
26 the submitted plan; and

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1 WHEREAS, upon HCFC approving the City's Standard Agreement to Apply for HHAP 3
2 program funding, a Standard Agreement for HHAP-3 Initial Disbursement Contract for Funds will be
3 prepared and sent to the City for processing.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside,
5 California, as follows:

6 Section 1: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to submit an application
7 to the California Homeless Coordinating and Financing Council for HHAP 3 funds.

8 Section 2: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to accept and receive a
9 grant of HHAP 3 funds in an amount up to and including Eight Million Four-Hundred Thirty-Three
10 Thousand Two Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars and Twenty-Two Cents (\$8,433,288.22) which is the
11 HHAP 3 base allocation in accordance with all applicable rules and laws.

12 Section 3: That the City of Riverside represents and certifies that, if it receives a grant of
13 HHAP 3 funds from the HCFC pursuant to the above referenced AB 140, it will use all such funds in
14 a manner consistent and in compliance with all applicable state and federal statutes, rules, regulations,
15 and laws, including without limitation all rules and laws regarding the HHAP 3 Program, as well as
16 any and all contracts it may have with the HCFC.

17 Section 4: That the City of Riverside hereby agrees to use the HHAP 3 funds only for
18 eligible activities as approved by the HCFC and in accordance with all Program requirements, HHAP
19 3 Program Guidelines, other rules and laws, as well as in a manner consistent and in compliance with
20 the HHAP-3 Initial Disbursement Contract for Funds, Standard Agreement, its Application, and other
21 contracts between the City of Riverside and the State of California and/or HCFC.

22 Section 5: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to enter into and execute
23 all other necessary documents to apply for, receive, and administer the HHAP 3 grant, and to perform
24 other actions necessary to fulfill the intent of receiving, administering, and disbursing the City of
25 Riverside's HHAP 3 funding.
