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SANTA ANA RIVER BOTTOM

- One of the largest concentrations of homeless encampments in Riverside County.
- Present unique challenges and opportunities to launch a coordinated response effort which addresses homelessness, restores habitat and prevents future encampments.



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SAR PLAN GOALS

- 1. Rehouse existing encampment residents living in the Santa Ana River Bottom Area.
- 2. Remove and mitigate physical encampments.
- 3. Conduct clean-up and habitat restoration.
- 4. Establish effective tools to prevent the reoccurrence of encampments.



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SAR PLAN OUTCOMES AND PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENTS

- Placements into housing, referrals to services.
- Reduction of environmental impacts, fire incidents.
- Trail accessibility.
- Trash/debris removed.
- Recidivism.
