3. Resource Development – Guidehouse Presentation

Guidehouse presenters, Peter Asmus and Laura Manz, presented to the Board how microgrids can provide grid reliability and resilience services. Mr. Asmus covered the microgrid trends overview, included global shift in energy sources, DER growth and policy influences for microgrids, the global perspectives, market drivers and barriers, and market segments. Mr. Asmus also covered the California and Public Power Perspectives, included the California Legislative and Regulatory influences on microgrids and DER growth, California's regulatory environment for microgrids, and public power advantages in deploying microgrids. Ms. Manz concluded the presentation with case studies.
