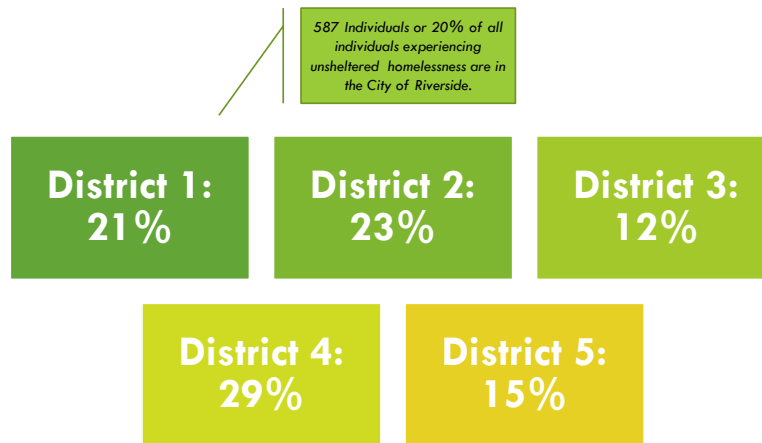
Plan, coordinate and implement housing and supportive services to move people experiencing homelessness toward stable housing and maximum self-sufficiency.

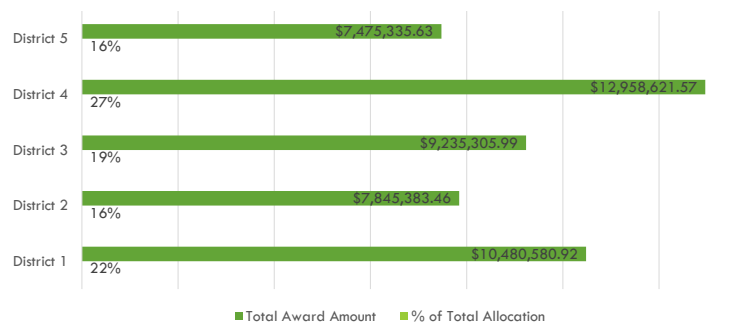
UNSHELTERED HOMELESSNESS ACROSS OUR COUNTY

According to the 2020 Annual Homeless Point-in-Time Count, there are 2,884 sheltered (729) and unsheltered (2,155) individuals throughout the County.



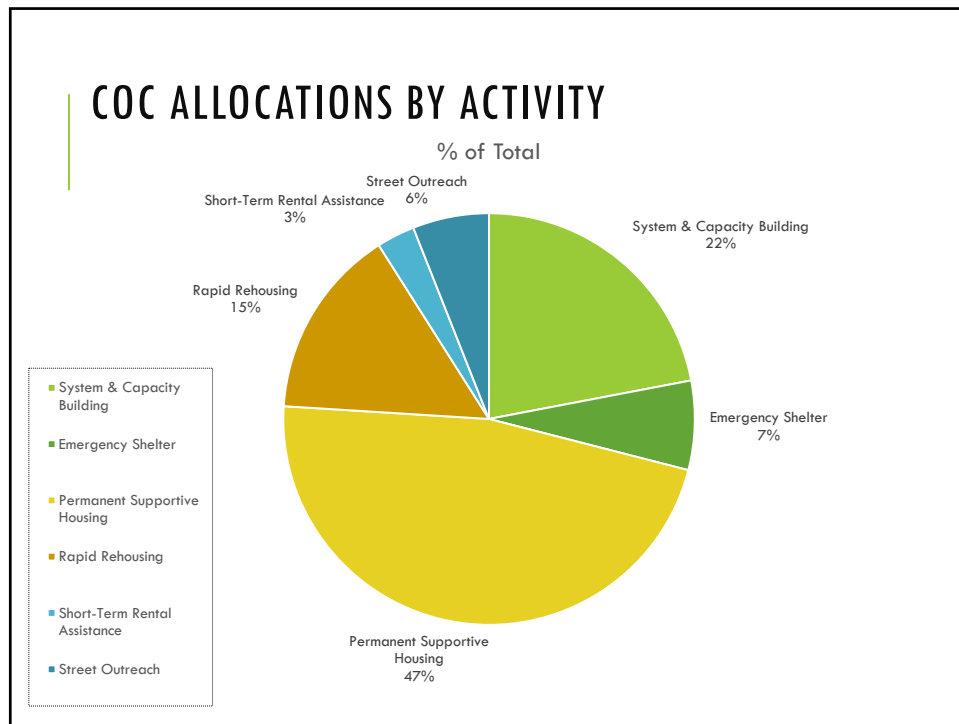
