BACKGROUND

- 1. Established locally in 2016, Riverside ExCITE is non-profit startup incubator that is a partnership between the City of Riverside, the University of California, Riverside and the County of Riverside.
- 2. In 2018, UCR's EPIC Small Business Development Center (EPIC SBDC) program was launched to support the development and launch of tech startups in the region.
- 3. As separate entities, Riverside ExCITE and UCR's EPIC SBDC bring together a unique combination of services, targeting support for technology startup companies engaged in research and development of advanced technologies.

DISCUSSION

- 1. Riverside ExCITE and UCR's EPIC SBDC focus exclusively on the acceleration of technology startup companies, including clean & green technology innovations, making ExCITE unique among our local and regional business support partners.
- 2. Riverside ExCITE and UCR's EPIC SBDC are located in the Innovation District, serving entrepreneurs Citywide and beyond, which helps further the City's goal for the district to serve as a regional hub for technology startup companies.
- 3. Riverside ExCITE and UCR's EPIC SBDC pursue and engage with new Riverside-based startups from our local universities, colleges and other regional higher learning institutions, supporting talent retention and local business growth.
- 4. Grant support is critical to their success. Without it, ExCITE would not be able to maintain their location in downtown Riverside.

UC Riverside's EPIC SBDC provides individualized support to early- stage tech entrepreneurs and companies in the Inland Empire to grow their businesses at no cost. Services include specialized consulting, training programs and workshops, access to capital and SBIR/STTR grant assistance.

EPIC SBDC has a pool of 16 experienced senior business executives who serve as Entrepreneurs in Residence to provide business consulting to help tech startups launch, scale and raise capital.



The EPIC SBDC team moved UCR lab spin out Si Li-ion along the path to commercialization.

Milestones

- •Identified and hired CEO Mark Hatch
- •Worked to get Si Li-ion accepted into the Cleantech San Diego SCEIN program
- •Assisted the founders on company creation and accounting system set-up to be able to receive a \$700,000 in grant awards
- •Si Li-ion is one of 12 Semi-finalists in Riverside Angel Summit competing for \$100,000 in Angel investment



Recommendations

That the Economic Development, Placemaking, and Branding/Marketing Committee recommend that the City Council:

- 1. Approve a two-year economic opportunity grant agreement for Fiscal Years 2021-2023 in the total amount of \$50,000 to be paid in annual installments of \$25,000 for UCRs EPIC SBDC;
- 2. Approve a two-year economic opportunity grant agreement for Fiscal Years 2021-2023 in the total amount of \$50,000 to be paid in annual installments of \$25,000 for ExCITE Riverside; and
- 3. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute both Agreements, including making minor and non-substantive changes to complete the transactions.
