RIVERSIDE ACCELERATING CLEAN ENERGY (RACE) BY 2040 STUDY

Following discussion, it was moved by Vice Chair Fierro and seconded by Member Edwards to recommend that the City Council approve the Funds-In Agreement - Nonfederal Sponsor for the development of the Riverside Accelerating Clean Energy by 2040 (RACE/2040) Study with the United States Department of Energy facility contractor, Alliance for Sustainable Energy, LLC, manager and operator of the National Renewable Energy Laboratory, for a two-year period in the amount of \$8,182,790 plus ten percent change order authority of \$818,310, for total not-to-exceed amount of \$9,001,100, and authorization of a supplemental appropriation. The motion carried unanimously.

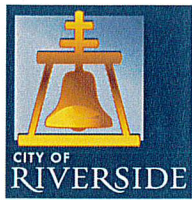
TEMPORARY AND LONG-TERM OUTDOOR DINING PROGRAMS UPDATE
