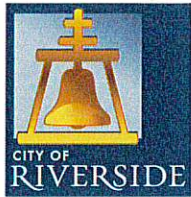

#### 2022 RESHAPE RIVERSIDE REDISTRICTING PROCESS UPDATE

Hearing was called on the Reshape Riverside Redistricting Plan. Twelve people spoke on the matter. The public hearing was officially closed.

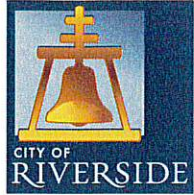
Following discussion and without formal motion, the Committee directed staff to (1) eliminate Draft Map A, Eastside and University, Triangle Arts and Innovation District, Howard Vine and Park Avenues; (2) draft a new map with the triangle; (3) increase communication and outreach efforts; and (4) uplift 8321 modified Community of Interest (COI) with slight modifications to include more majority/minority districts.

### DISCUSSION CALENDAR

#### CODE OF THICS AND CONDUCT

Following discussion, it was moved by Vice Chair Perry and seconded by Member Conder to (1) accept the proposed changes to the Code of Ethics and Conduct by the Board of Ethics and the Committee; and (2) recommend the City Council consider the

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recommendations; and (3) forward recommendations to Inclusiveness, Community Engagement, and Governmental Processes Committee for further deliberation of the Code of Ethics and Conduct for a future meeting date. The motion carried unanimously.
