Public Works Director Hernandez provided to the Committee the following announcements and updates including the Fairmount Park Pilot Project, Clean Up Riverside Environment (CURE) events are back throughout the community, Clean California Grant for disadvantaged communities which may include area cleaning, litter abatement, public art, landscaping, lighting, tree planting, and replacement of park playground equipment. The Wastewater Division is working on a partnership with private companies to convert organic waste into gas project. Street paving is currently on hold due to cold and rainy weather. The Market Street Bridge needed emergency work to fix an eroding pier foundation and staff is working with the State for reimbursement of the emergency work. Grant submittal updates coming soon from the State regarding the Market Street Bridge, Mission Bridge, and the Third Street Grade Separation projects.
