#### UPDATES FROM THE RIVERSIDE POLICE DEPARTMENT

Captain Payne reported new recruits to the police academy with a total of 24 and classes will start in January 2024.

#### UPDATES FROM THE CITY MANAGER'S OFFICE

Report of the following City Council items associated with RPD:

#### August 15, 2023

- (1) Purchase and installation of 80 Flock Falcon Camera Systems from Flock Group, Inc. for \$1,013,500 annually, with an additional \$200,00 per year.
- (2) The Measure Z Fund has waived the formal procurement process for the purchase of new and used vehicles and motorcycles for the Police Department and Public Safety Engagement Team, totaling \$3,100,000 for a six-month term ending January 31, 2024.
- (3) Approval of the annual review of the Military Equipment Policy, which outlines the acquisition and deployment of law enforcement equipment, is being conducted in accordance with Assembly Bill 481.

#### September 5, 2023

- (1) The Housing and Homelessness Committee recommends discontinuing the Crime Free MultiHousing Program and supporting multi-family housing operations through

Neighborhood Policing Centers, Neighborhood Watch Programs, and safety education.

- (2) The City Council of Riverside, California, has proposed a reward of \$20,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the perpetrators of the attempted murder of Izaak Colunga and Domonic Castillo.
- (3) The City of Riverside has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the US Postal Inspection Services - Contraband Interdiction and Investigations Task Force, requesting a supplementary appropriation of \$30,907 for an assigned Officer.

### ITEMS FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION AS REQUESTED BY COMMISSION MEMBERS OR CPRC MANAGER

Manager Megan Stoye reported a National Night Out for police department on October 3rd as a great opportunity for commissioner to go out to the community and perform outreach efforts. Manager Megan Stoye informed the commission of an event that requires the commission's participation, "planes and treats" at Riverside Municipal Airport on October 14th. Manager Megan Stoye reminded the commission there will be no meeting in November 2023.

Vice Chair Teichert requested to agendaize the 2023 RIPA Report Analysis Review with additional data requested with City Manager's response.

Frank Hauptman requested to agendaize a vote for findings for Officer Involve Death – P19-08054 - A. Luther during the next regular meeting.
