There were no oral communications given at this time.

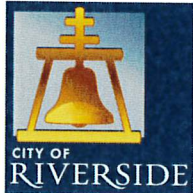
DISCUSSION CALENDAR

FOOD TRUCKS AND UNPERMITTED SIDEWALK VENDORS UPDATE

Following discussion, and without formal motion, the Committee (1) received and ordered filed on the current regulations and enforcement efforts regarding food trucks with potential code amendments and enforcement strategies for unpermitted, compliance resistant sidewalk vendors; and (2) directed staff on potential code amendments regarding food trucks, including but not limited to 50-foot parking restriction adjacent to driveway and restriction from parking food truck on roadways with speed limits over 35 MPH, with additional restrictions for food truck vendors and unpermitted sidewalk vendors as follows: (a) reduce speed limit to 35 mph on Diana Street (cross/Tyler), (b) use of street classifications rather than mph to regulate food trucks, (c) explore a permitting process for issuance of street use permits for food trucks, (d) explore food truck lots for food trucks on private property, and (d) implement confiscation of equipment, small claims or injunction for repeat offenders.
