AGREEMENT AMENDMENT - AMEC FOSTER WHEELER ENVIRONMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE. INC. - 2993 SIXTH STREET - RESOLUTION

The Oversight Board (1) adopted a resolution authorizing the execution of the Third Amendment Agreement with Amec Foster Wheeler Environment and Infrastructure, Inc. not-to-exceed \$250,000 to complete the Phase II Environmental Site Assessment and prepare a Remedial Action Plan for the Riverside Scrap property located at 2993 Sixth Street; and (2) authorized the Executive Director, or his designee, to take any and all actions including making minor and non-substantive modifications and execute the Third Amendment with Amec Foster Wheeler; whereupon, the title having been read and further reading waived, Resolution No. 91 of the Oversight Board for City of Riverside as Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Riverside approving a third amendment to Professional Consultant Services Agreement with Amec Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure, Inc. to increase the compensation and for additional Phase II Environmental Site Assessment and preparation of a Remedial Action Plan, was presented and adopted.
