#### **POLICE TOW TRUCK SERVICE AGREEMENT**

Following discussion, motion was made by Member Burnard and seconded by Vice Chair Melendrez (1) to receive and order filed the report on the proposed changes to the 2017-2019 Official Police Tow Truck Service agreement; and (2) recommending that the City Council approve the new two-year agreement, including additional language regarding Item No. 6 - Failure to meet yard standards relating to a 10-day time frame to make necessary corrections. Motion carried unanimously.

#### **RIVERSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDMENTS RELATING TO CAMPING AND STORAGE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY ON CITY PROPERTY**

Following discussion, motion was made by Member Burnard and seconded by Chair Perry recommending that the City Council approve adoption of the proposed amendments to Sections 6.15.020, 9.04.600, and 13.04.10 of the Riverside Municipal Code prohibiting camping on public property. Motion carried unanimously.


There were no oral communications at this time.
