Following discussion, motion was made by Member Burnard and seconded by Vice Chair Melendrez recommending that the City Council adopt an ordinance to amend Chapter 9.58 of the Riverside Municipal Code relating to the retrieval, impound, and disposal of lost, stolen, or abandoned shopping carts. 
Rebecca Velasquez spoke regarding a property on Spruce Street.
