TRANSPORTATION BOARD City of Riverside Wednesday, June 7, 2017, 5:30 p.m. Art Pick Council Chamber

Chair Moran called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion was made by Member Brown and seconded by Member Martin approving the May 3, 2017, Transportation Board meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

DISCUSSION CALENDAR

EAST LA CADENA DRIVE - ESTABLISHMENT OF TIMED PARKING ZONE

Following discussion motion was made by Chair Moran and seconded by Vice Chair Armas recommending that the City Council approve establishment of a "No Parking between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Daily" Zone on both sides of East La Cadena Drive from Kansas Avenue westerly to the cul-de-sac terminus. Motion carried unanimously.

ESTABLISHMENT OF 5-TON WEIGHT LIMIT RESTRICTION – RIVERSIDE AVENUE

Following discussion motion was made by Chair Moran and seconded by Vice Chair Armas recommending that the City Council approve establishment of a 5-ton weight limit restriction on Riverside Avenue from Jurupa Avenue to Central Avenue. Motion carried unanimously.

POTOMAC STREET – ESTABLISHMENT OF PREFERENTIAL PARKING ZONE

Two residents spoke in support regarding the establishment of a timed "No Parking between the hours of 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Daily, with Preferential Permit Parking for residents" Zone on both sides of Potomac Street from Lillian Street westerly to the cul-de-sac terminus. The residents requested the "No Parking" hours be changed to 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Following discussion motion was made by Chair Moran and seconded by Member Martin recommending that the City Council approve establishment of a timed "No Parking between the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Daily with Preferential Permit Parking for residents" Zone on both sides of Potomac Street from Lillian Street westerly to the cul-de-sac terminus. Motion carried unanimously.

CITY TRAFFIC ENGINEER UPDATES

COUNCIL ACTIONS

City Traffic Engineer Gilbert Hernandez provided the Board with an update regarding the recent City Council elections for Wards 2, 4 and 6. Councilmember Melendrez of Ward 2 and Councilmember Perry of Ward 6 were re-elected. Councilmember Davis of Ward 4, lost to challenger Chuck Conder. Councilmember Davis was the chair for the Transportation Committee, we have not been informed if Councilmember Conder will be the new chair or if Councilmembers MacArthur or Melendrez who currently serve on the committee will take on the role as Chair. Bid 7467 was awarded June 6, 2017. This project will install the first flashing yellow left-turn indications in the city. Following discussion and without formal motion the Transportation Board unanimously received and ordered filed the update.

UPDATES

Updates were provided for presentations from Riverside Transit Agency, the City's Planning Department, Riverside City College, and Riverside County Transportation Commission for future Transportation Board meetings. Temporary Pedestrian Scramble improvements have been installed at Market Street at Mission Inn Avenue. The One-Stop Shop is up and running, bringing together Public Works, Planning, Public Utilities, Building and Safety and other divisions all on one floor to streamline the review and approval of the building permit process. Following discussion and without formal motion the Transportation Board unanimously received and ordered filed the update.
