

## **MINUTES**

### **PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE Wednesday, January 17, 2018, 1 p.m. Art Pick Council Chamber**

**PRESENT:** Chair Perry, Vice Chair Melendrez, and Member Adams

Chair Perry called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.

#### **REVOCAION OF MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT - APPEAL - IVY MASSAGE SPA - 10220 HOLE AVENUE #8**

Following discussion, motion was made by Member Adams and seconded by Vice Chair Melendrez to deny the appeal of Xiaojing Li of Ivy Massage Spa based on the evidence presented.

The denial is based on Section 5.52.130 of the Riverside Municipal Code and specifically, on the grounds that the holder of the establishment permit or certificate of registration is acting in a manner (a) contrary to the provisions of this code; (b) that constitutes a public nuisance; and (c) that is detrimental to the health, safety or welfare of the city or its inhabitants.

Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Perry advised that pursuant to the vote, the Public Safety Committee is hereby denying the appeal of Xiaojing Li, owner of Ivy Massage Spa. The decision of the Public Safety Committee is final with no further right of appeal to the City Council. Because there is no provision for reconsideration of the decision, or for a written decision or written findings supporting the decision in any applicable provision of any statute, charter, or rule, this decision is final today. The appellant may seek judicial review of the decision pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1094.5 by filing a petition with the Riverside County Superior Court. The time within which judicial review must be sought is governed by Section 1094.6.


