# REVOCATION OF MASSAGE ESTABLISHMENT PERMIT - APPEAL - COCO **RELAXATIONS - 1299 GALLERIA AT TYLER #2124**

Following discussion, motion was made by Vice Chair Melendrez and seconded by Chair Perry to deny the appeal of Ying Wang, owner Coco Relaxations based on the evidence presented.

The denial is based on Section 5.52.130 of the Riverside Municipal Code and specifically, on the grounds that the holder of the establishment permit or certificate of registration is acting in a manner (a) contrary to the provisions of this code; (b) that constitutes a public nuisance; and (c) that is detrimental to the health, safety or welfare of the City or its inhabitants.

Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Perry advised that pursuant to the vote, the Public Safety Committee is hereby denying the appeal of Ying Wang, owner of Coco Relaxations. The decision of the Public Safety Committee is final with no further right of appeal to the City Council. Because there is no provision for reconsideration of the decision, or for a written decision or written findings supporting the decision in any applicable provision of any statute, charter, or rule, this decision is final today. The appellant may seek judicial review of the decision pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1094.5 by filing a petition with the Riverside County Superior Court. The time within which judicial review must be sought is governed by Section 1094.6.
